



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## The Opportunity

Elliot Health System seeks a dynamic, strategic leader to serve as its next Senior Vice President, Chief Legal Officer and General Counsel (CLO.) For over 135 years, Elliot Health System (EHS) has been dedicated to inspiring wellness, healing patients, and serving with compassion in every interaction. As CLO, this leader will play a pivotal role in guiding the organization through an increasingly complex regulatory and operational landscape, ensuring that every legal decision supports EHS's mission to deliver compassionate, high-quality care.

Elliot Health System, with over \$1 Billion in annual revenues and over 4,000 team members, is the largest provider of comprehensive healthcare services in southern New Hampshire, providing high quality, cost-effective programs across the continuum of care. EHS's patient-centered, innovative services cover more than 117,000 lives in its network, as well as numerous other individuals throughout its total service area spanning New Hampshire communities. The cornerstone of EHS is Elliot Hospital, a 296-bed acute care facility located in Manchester that offers southern New Hampshire communities caring, compassionate, and professional patient service, regardless of race, religion, national origin, gender, age, disability, marital status, sexual preference, or ability to pay.

Reporting directly to the President and Chief Executive Officer for EHS, W. Gregory Baxter, M.D., the CLO will serve as a legal advisor to leadership and the Board of Directors. As a highly visible and engaged member of the Executive Leadership Team (ELT), this executive will provide legal insight with respect to the strategic direction of the organization and participate in a wide range of projects where legal, regulatory and compliance knowledge is needed. The CLO will oversee outside counsel and provide guidance on all legal initiatives, including advising on corporate and commercial transactions (including joint ventures and other strategic alliances), litigation, employment, regulatory matters, intellectual property and other aspects of system development and integration. The CLO is also the senior leader for compliance, internal audit and government affairs.

The individual selected for this position will be a highly strategic, proactive attorney who is well versed in the business dynamics and regulatory environment of the healthcare industry. They are innovative and entrepreneurial, and someone who creates solutions that facilitate EHS's strategy to assure success and growth. Working with the CEO, ELT and Board of Directors, the CLO will be constantly thinking of better ways to operate and how to structure these growth opportunities.

The legal team is responsible for providing legal counsel to EHS in subject areas germane to business matters, mergers and acquisitions, joint ventures, fraud and abuse, employment, patient care, regulatory, physician practices, managed care/third party reimbursement, risk management, health care services and government relations. Members of the legal team will serve as strategic business partners of the organization, who proactively provide counsel and training in subject matters related to the health system.

The ideal candidate will be a seasoned, results-oriented legal leader with a proven track record of success in complex healthcare organizations. The successful candidate will possess strong leadership and relationship-building skills, with the emotional intelligence to partner effectively across all levels of the organization. They will have outstanding academic credentials, including a law degree from an ABA-accredited law school, and active membership in the New Hampshire Bar Association or eligibility for admission based on reciprocity is required. A minimum of ten years of experience as an attorney supporting hospitals, health systems, or other healthcare providers is required, with demonstrated expertise in healthcare regulatory matters, healthcare contracting, physician alignment, healthcare litigation, and healthcare transactions. Prior executive-level leadership experience overseeing legal teams in a dynamic, integrated health system—and success in leveraging technology and operational improvements to enhance departmental performance—is strongly preferred.

Elliot Health System is home to Manchester's designated Regional Trauma Center, a state-of-the art Level 3 Newborn Intensive Care Unit, Elliot Breast Health Center, Elliot Heart and Vascular Center, the Solinsky Center for Cancer Care at The Elliot, Elliot Urgent Care, Elliot Senior Health Center, The Elliot VNA, 1-Day Surgery Center, NH Arthritis Center, Elliot Retail Pharmacy, and Elliot Medical Centers in Bedford, Londonderry, Hooksett, and The Elliot at River's Edge.

### Signature Services

#### Level II Regional Trauma Center

Elliot Health System’s Emergency Department includes a 32-bed, full-service, Level II Trauma Center, providing high-acuity care for patients and their families; the department manages over 61,000 patient visits per year. The department delivers extraordinary coverage, consisting of board-certified-and-board-eligible emergency medicine physicians, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, and trauma and critical care surgeons. The trauma team is staffed by board-certified or board-eligible trauma and critical care surgeons, offering year-round, round-the-clock care to manage and treat traumatic needs of any child or adult in the community.

Verified by the American College of Surgeons and specializing in the care and rehabilitation of the critically injured through comprehensive surgical and medical specialties, the department provides specialized trauma care around

the clock in three state-of-the-art trauma bays, utilizing a team approach to care led by emergency physicians and board-certified trauma surgeons who consult with specialists from related fields, such as anesthesiology, neurosurgery and orthopedics.

## Elliot Women's & Children's Services

Delivering the most babies in the region, Elliot's specialty-trained, board-certified physicians and certified nurse midwives are experts at providing patients and infants with compassionate care and exceptional attention. As the only maternity center in the area with a full suite of labor and delivery rooms and postpartum rooms, Elliot has the expertise and flexibility to manage all patients' birthing needs.

Elliot Hospital's Women's and Children's services are comprised of a compassionate team committed to providing patients with personalized, family-centered care. Using state-of-the-art equipment and the latest advances in medicine, the organization's specialty trained physicians have expertise in obstetrics, pediatrics, maternal-fetal medicine, neonatal intensive care and pediatric specialties including surgery, gastroenterology, neurology and integrative medicine.

### Neonatal Intensive Care Unit

Elliot's NICU team is committed to providing superb care specific to the needs of patients and their babies. Elliot's state-of-the-art facility houses 34 beds, where clinical professionals treat more than 600 critically ill and premature infants each year. In this nurturing environment, patients receive the highly sensitive, personalized care they need.

Recognized regionally for top-quality care since 1989, Elliot's Level III NICU has touched the lives of thousands of families across the region and beyond. Few parents anticipate their newborns needing intensive care. When there is no time for doubt, patients can count on Elliot's expert interdisciplinary team of medical professionals and an array of specialized pediatric medical and surgical services to ensure their baby receives expert care provided in a nurturing, family-oriented setting that's conveniently located close to home.

### Pediatrics

Highly regarded for being at the forefront of pediatric medicine in New Hampshire, Elliot also has a dedicated Pediatric Emergency Department in addition to its Level III Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU).

## Solinsky Center for Cancer Care at The Elliot

Elliot Hospital was a pioneer in oncology when it opened the first cancer center in New Hampshire in 1966. Today, the Solinsky Center for Cancer Care remains a leader in cancer care specializing in breast oncology, medical oncology, and radiation oncology, supported by trained specialists and team members, plus state-of-the-art technology – all in an accessible, aesthetically pleasing, comforting environment in one convenient location. These are important factors to support patients in reaching their goals for successful treatment with comprehensive, accessible care close to home.

## Heart and Vascular Care

With cardiovascular mortality trending upward in New Hampshire, The Elliot responded to the growing demand for increased cardiovascular services – expanding its Heart and Vascular program offerings at its' Heart and Vascular Center – located at 4 Elliot Way in Manchester – **to create a pathway to increase access to advanced heart care and surgical services**. The Elliot recently expanded their service offerings with the launch of open-heart surgery – with the inaugural open-heart surgery case performed at The Elliot in July 2025 by Dr. Gerald Sardella, cardiothoracic surgeon with more than 30 years of experience treating patients for their heart and thoracic needs, along with a highly trained multidisciplinary team.

Their Heart and Vascular program combine patient-focused care in a highly compassionate, team-based approach, guided by Dr. Carl Fier, and the region's most trusted clinical experts and surgeons. With the addition of cardiothoracic surgery services, they offer a full suite of services through their Heart and Vascular program – from advanced cardiac diagnostics to interventional cardiovascular care to complex surgery and cardiac rehabilitation. This positions The Elliot as a comprehensive, integrated heart care destination with deep experience to treat a wide range of cardiology, thoracic, and vascular conditions. Their experienced teams deliver the latest in advanced heart and vascular care and intervention to support heart and lung health and wellness, disease prevention, and condition management for greater Manchester and to residents across New Hampshire.

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## Position Summary

### Reporting Relationships

Reporting to the President and Chief Executive Officer, the Senior Vice President, Chief Legal Officer and General Counsel serves in support of the organization's mission and goals related to patient care. This role serves as a point of contact for top management and the Board of Directors in providing information and resolving issues in all legal, compliance and risk matters. The Chief Legal Officer also participates as an active member of the Leadership Team; collaborates with peers to ensure optimal service delivery across the organization.

### Responsibilities

The successful Chief Legal Officer candidate will:

- Actively participate in senior level strategic planning and organizational decision-making while playing a key role as an advisor to the CEO and ELT in aligning legal strategies with Elliot Health System's mission, vision, and long-term objectives. The CLO will ensure legal perspectives are seamlessly integrated into enterprise-wide strategies, policies, and initiatives while fostering proactive risk management and operational alignment.
- Provide oversight, direction, and guidance related to Government Relations matters on behalf of the Health System.
- Oversee and direct the provision of legal support services related to Health System operations, programs, facilities and personnel in an appropriate and timely manner. In partnership with the appropriate executive partners, the CLO will provide and direct legal support related to appropriate subject matters, including but not limited to: clinical, operational and business areas; corporate transactions (including but not limited to acquisitions, real estate transactions, joint ventures and partnerships, financing arrangements, contracts and agreements); corporate governance (Board and Board committees, bylaws, articles of incorporation, LLC agreements, etc.); labor and employment issues; medical staff issues (professional practice evaluation, credentialing, discipline, etc.); government agency regulations and licensure; government agency and law enforcement investigations; internal investigations; intellectual property and licensing; nonprofit and community benefit support; tax and audit support; insurance support and related matters.
- Supervise and manage the provision of all corporate compliance services related to Health System operations, programs, facilities and personnel in an appropriate and timely manner. The next CLO will provide corporate compliance services related to appropriate subject matters, including but not limited to: billing and coding compliance; government and payer audits; whistleblower and compliance hotline; healthcare fraud and abuse laws including Stark and Anti-Kickback Statute; privacy laws including HIPAA; guardianship and probate related matters; involuntary emergency admissions; patient, parent and guardian rights and consent issues; advance directives; system-wide policy coordination; and other related matters.
- Administer and lead the provision of all risk management services related to Health System operations, programs, facilities and personnel in an appropriate and timely manner. This leader is responsible for risk management services related to appropriate subject matters, including but not limited to risk identification including enterprise assessment, mitigation, education and training; risk tracking and trending; occurrence reporting; serious event reviews; adverse event disclosures; state reportable event submission; and other related matters.
- Maintain responsibility for the provision of all claims management services related to Health System operations, programs, facilities and personnel in an appropriate and timely manner. Claims management services are part of this CLO's purview, including but not limited to management of claims and suits in conjunction with insurers, third party administrators and outside counsel; witness issues; subpoenas and search warrants; and other related matters.

- In partnership with the Chief Quality Officer, oversee and direct the provision of all Institutional Review Board (clinical trials and bioethics oversight) services to the Board of Directors, management and appropriate personnel in an appropriate and timely manner.
- Assist, at the direction of the COO, and in concert with the Incident Command Structure, with the organizational program to ensure effective readiness for and response to emergency and disaster scenarios, in compliance with all applicable laws, regulations and standards.
- Work alongside the Vice President of Operational Excellence and Strategy to ensure effective readiness for and response to accreditation agency surveys, investigations and inquiries, in compliance with all applicable standards.
- Manage the department's budget and develop department strategic plans (based on organization strategic initiatives) and fiscal goals; Coordinate requests for services for and maintain relationships with outside counsel and other consultants in an appropriate and cost-effective manner.
- Foster communication and collaboration within and outside of the department.
- Organize and supervise personnel in legal services, corporate compliance, risk management, claims management, IRB; ultimately overseeing all hiring, orientation, supervision, evaluation, personnel decisions, training and related matters.
- Direct the provision of legal educational programs and training for management and appropriate personnel.
- Provide expert input on committees in areas related to legal aspects of health care delivery.
- Ensure confidentiality of employees, legal, budget and Health System matters; Maintain good communications; establish and nurture positive working relationships with employees, regulatory agencies, vendors and the public.
- Respond to requests from leaders to draft, review and/or revise contracts, policies and related documentation as appropriate; Assist in developing and maintaining computerized tracking system(s) to track the progress and completion of contracts.
- Work consistently to demonstrate the mission, vision, beliefs, core values and standards of behavior of EHS.

## Goals and Objectives

The following goals and objectives have been identified as priorities for this position:

- Gain credibility, trust and respect of the CEO, Executive Leadership Team, physician leadership and Board of Directors.
- Be recognized as a strategic thinker, insightful, responsive, collaborative and approachable, with strong follow-through; someone who provides solid legal advice based upon an understanding of the business of medicine and healthcare.
- Assure that all legal services are provided at a high level of service and that the legal department is recognized as collaborative, responsive, business focused and problem solving. Clarify the structure and the services provided by the legal department, and enhance the recognition of the value of services offered by the legal team.
- Optimize the balance between internal legal capabilities and external counsel by strengthening in-house expertise and streamlining processes. Establish a clear decision-making rubric for leveraging external counsel to ensure investments are made judiciously, with internal capabilities prioritized for routine and operational matters while reserving outside expertise for high-complexity or specialized legal needs.
- Evaluate the current legal team structure and design a future-forward organizational model. Lead recruitment efforts to fill key roles and implement a robust onboarding process to support team integration and success.
- Further develop and support a business-oriented, problem-solving approach to legal services in Elliot Health System's legal department. Support and maintain an approach that will first seek to understand the strategic issue surrounding the question and explore creative but legally appropriate alternatives to matters that EHS faces.
- Support the innovative and highly collaborative culture of EHS by being savvy in the business of healthcare, the local and national landscape and the critical success factors under health care reform.
