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The Opportunity

Jupiter Medical Center seeks an experienced, forward-thinking technology leader to serve as its Director, Business Applications (Director). This individual will play a central role in advancing the organization's business application portfolio, including revenue cycle systems, to ensure critical systems effectively support the medical center's mission, strategic priorities, and operational excellence.

Reporting to the Vice President and Chief Information Officer, [Kevin Olson](#), the Director will be a key member of the IT leadership team and will work closely with the Chief Financial Officer and financial operations team. In collaboration and with input from others, the Director will be responsible for anticipating operational needs, delivering technology solutions that improve efficiency and reduce total cost of ownership, and executing a unified, business-aligned roadmap for enterprise applications.

The Director will guide the enhancement and long-term optimization of Jupiter Medical Center's business applications, including Epic and Workday, which support finance, accounting, procurement, supply chain, human resources, billing, and reimbursement. The Director ensures these systems operate as reliable, scalable foundations for daily operations and long-range strategic initiatives.

A key aspect of this role is the strategic partnership with Ensemble, which manages outsourced revenue cycle operations. The Director will work closely with Ensemble to align workflows, performance goals, and automation capabilities; coordinate enhancements; manage integration points across the Epic ecosystem; and resolve issues that affect billing and reimbursement. The Director will serve as a primary liaison between Ensemble, internal stakeholders, and IT leadership to drive transparency, accountability, and continuous improvement.

The Director will keep executive leadership informed on progress, risks, system performance, and resource needs. They will safeguard the integrity, security, and reliability of business systems during upgrades, integrations, and enhancements. This leader will ensure projects are delivered on time and within budget while promoting accountability and effective change management across the organization. The Director will also shape and refine standards, governance practices, and procedures that support quality, compliance, and operational efficiency. Strong partnerships with leaders, staff, clinicians, and key vendors will be essential.

The ideal candidate will have a strong blend of technical, operational, and leadership experience in a complex healthcare environment. They should bring deep expertise in enterprise application management, including hands-on experience with ERP and revenue cycle platforms, and a solid understanding of financial, supply chain, and human resources modules. Success leading high-performing teams, managing large application portfolios, and guiding system upgrades, integrations, and process improvements is essential. Strong collaboration, communication, vendor management, and change-management skills are required. A bachelor's degree in information technology, business administration, or a related field is required; a master's degree or relevant certifications is preferred.

Organization Overview

Founded in 1979, Jupiter Medical Center (JMC) is an independent, not-for-profit regional medical center nationally recognized for excellence in quality, safety, and patient experience. With 340 licensed beds and more than 2,500 professionals, including more than 750 physicians across 80 specialties, JMC delivers world-class care supported by annual revenues exceeding \$600 million.

The organization consistently achieves the highest ratings for quality, safety, and patient experience in Palm Beach County and the Treasure Coast. It is the only 4-star rated hospital across Palm Beach, Martin, and St. Lucie counties. Patient experience scores at JMC exceed both Florida and national averages. For the 14th straight year, JMC has received Leapfrog Grade 'A' for Hospital Patient Safety.

JMC is also recognized for its strong culture of excellence. In 2025, Forbes named JMC among America's Best Midsize Employers and America's Best Employers for Women, ranking it the #1 hospital nationally and #4 across 25 industries for midsize employers. Additionally, in 2023, Press Ganey honored JMC with the Physician Experience Excellence Award.

Through award-winning physicians, cutting-edge technology, and strategic partnerships, JMC remains steadfast in its mission to deliver the highest level of care and advance health throughout the region. Recent strategic growth initiatives include the opening of the Johnny & Terry Gray Surgical Institute in January 2024, a 90,000-square-foot facility featuring 16 smart operating rooms, two hybrid surgical suites, 16 pre-op rooms, 21 PACU bays, and 10 Phase II recovery rooms. Equipped with advanced robotics, 3D-guided imaging, real-time data feeds, and enhanced infection control systems, the institute sets a new benchmark for surgical innovation. In July 2025, JMC expanded its capabilities with a second hybrid operating room, increasing capacity for structural heart cases and electrophysiology procedures. Two additional EP labs are planned for late 2027.

In June 2023, JMC partnered with PAM Health to open the PAM Health Rehabilitation Hospital of Jupiter, a 50,000-square-foot, two-story facility with 42 inpatient rehabilitation beds, providing comprehensive recovery services close to home. Continuing its commitment to growth, JMC recently opened a state-of-the-art 92-bed patient care tower. This \$155 million investment includes oncology, orthopedic, and cardiac units, as well as a clinical simulation lab, patient experience center, and administrative offices. To improve accessibility, JMC constructed a five-story parking pavilion with 800 spaces, including 92 dedicated spots for physicians.

Further expanding its reach, The Neighborhood Hospital at Avenir, scheduled to open in 2027, will bring advanced care closer to home for residents in the surrounding communities. This state-of-the-art facility will feature 29 inpatient beds, an 11-bed emergency department, and four operating room suites supported by 12 pre- and post-surgical beds. Diagnostic capabilities will include CT, ultrasound, and MRI, ensuring comprehensive on-site imaging services. The campus will also include a modern medical office building designed to house physician offices and a range of outpatient services, including physical therapy, wound care, women's imaging, and an outpatient laboratory. This integrated approach will create a convenient, patient-centered care environment.

These strategic expansions ensure that JMC continues to deliver exceptional care, convenience, and innovation to the community. Supporting this growth, JMC successfully transitioned to the EPIC electronic health record system in August 2024, reinforcing its commitment to advanced data integration and patient-centered care.

JMC's mission to provide exceptional care extends beyond its campus through robust community wellness initiatives, including health education programs, preventive screenings, employer health fairs, and sponsorship of meaningful causes. By staying closely connected to the community, JMC collaborates to build better health outcomes year after year.

Surgical Services

Jupiter Medical Center delivers exceptional inpatient, outpatient, and specialty surgical services, offering the highest standard of care for patients with both simple and complex medical conditions. Its surgical team performs more than 15,000 procedures annually, serving adults and children across a broad spectrum of specialties. These include minimally invasive and robotic surgeries, such as cardiac and oncologic procedures for gynecologic, thoracic, breast, gastrointestinal, and urologic cancers, as well as orthopedic, spine, and total joint replacement surgeries, plastic and reconstructive procedures, vascular and cardiac surgeries, arthroscopic and microsurgery, general surgery, urology, and gynecology.

Emergency Services

The Petrocelli Emergency Department at Jupiter Medical Center is one of the most advanced emergency care facilities in the region, treating more than 55,000 patients annually. Recently renovated and expanded, the department offers state-of-the-art clinical equipment, modern patient and triage areas, and a dedicated fast-track zone designed to treat patients with less severe medical needs efficiently. It also features a separate, 24/7 Pediatric Emergency Room exclusively for children up to 18 years of age, ensuring specialized care for the youngest patients.

Innovative processes have been implemented to reduce wait times and enhance the overall patient experience, while cutting-edge technology supports superior diagnostic accuracy. Among its advanced capabilities is a dedicated CT scanner equipped with True Fidelity technology, which uses artificial intelligence and deep learning image reconstruction to deliver exceptional imaging quality. These enhancements, combined with a commitment to patient-centered care, earned the department the distinction of **Best of Palm Beach County** by *The Palm Beach Post* in 2024.

Oncology

Jupiter Medical Center has long provided a full continuum of advanced cancer care for patients across Palm Beach County and the Treasure Coast. As a Commission on Cancer Accredited Program and a Quality Program of the American College of Surgeons, the Anderson Family Cancer Institute delivers award-winning oncology services that rival those of leading academic medical centers. Located on the JMC campus, the institute brings together a multidisciplinary team of highly skilled medical, surgical, and radiation oncologists supported by state-of-the-art technology to transform cancer care in the region and set a new standard for oncology in Florida.

The institute offers comprehensive programs and subspecialties, including Comprehensive Breast Care, Thoracic Surgery and Lung Center of Excellence, Gastrointestinal Oncology, recognized by the National Pancreas Foundation as a Pancreas Surgery Center of Excellence, and a dedicated Gynecologic Oncology Program. Patients also benefit from extensive support services, access to leading-edge clinical trials, a genetics and risk assessment program, and specialized nurse navigators who guide them through every stage of care.

Advanced technology is at the heart of the Anderson Family Cancer Institute, featuring innovations such as 3D Quorum Imaging powered by Genius AI for greater accuracy in breast imaging, Optellum® AI-based screening for early lung cancer detection, and 3D contrast-enhanced mammography. Combined with next-day oncologist appointments and a commitment to personalized care, these capabilities ensure that patients receive the most advanced treatments available.

Orthopedics

Recognized as one of the Top 100 Orthopedic Programs in the nation by Becker's Healthcare, Jupiter Medical Center delivers exceptional joint replacement and spine care for both inpatient and outpatient treatment. Through continuous investment in robotics and advanced technology, JMC offers a level of sophistication that rivals the most prestigious programs in the country.

The Orthopedic and Spine Center of Excellence provides cutting-edge surgical options, including Mako SmartRobotics for hip and knee procedures, Velys Robotic-Assisted Technology for total knee replacement, and the CORI Robotic-Assisted Surgical System for knee replacement surgeries. Patients benefit from personalized care guided by an Orthopedic & Spine Navigator and supported by customized rehabilitative services, ensuring optimal outcomes and seamless recovery experiences.

The new alliance with the Hospital for Special Surgery elevates orthopedic care at JMC. This partnership brings world-class expertise in joint replacement, sports medicine, spine surgery, and rehabilitation to JMC, positioning the organization as a premier destination for comprehensive musculoskeletal care.

Heart and Vascular Care

The Robson Heart & Vascular Institute at Jupiter Medical Center offers a full continuum of cardiac care, from wellness and preventive cardiology to advanced surgical interventions and rehabilitation, all within Palm Beach County. Services include cardiac imaging, non-invasive diagnostics, interventional cardiology, advanced electrophysiology for arrhythmia management, open-heart and robotic-assisted cardiac surgery, and comprehensive cardiac rehabilitation.

State-of-the-art facilities feature cardiac catheterization labs, electrophysiology labs for treating heart rhythm disorders, advanced cardiac operating suites, a cardiovascular intensive care unit (CVICU), and a dedicated acute recovery unit staffed by specialists in pre- and post-procedure care. Additional programs include the Atrial Fibrillation Center of Excellence, the Structural Heart Program and Valve Clinic, cardiac wellness initiatives, and robust rehabilitation services. Jupiter Medical Center has earned Chest Pain Certification from The Joint Commission and holds the Gold Seal of Approval for safe and effective cardiac care.

Expanding access to exceptional cardiac care, JMC offers advanced surgical options, including off-pump coronary artery bypass surgery, minimally invasive direct coronary artery bypass (MIDCAB), and minimally invasive aortic and mitral valve procedures. The institute also provides cutting-edge electrophysiology treatments and minimally invasive vascular procedures and benefits from the capabilities of the new Johnny & Terry Gray Surgical Institute, which includes hybrid operating suites for complex cardiac cases.

Stroke

As a Joint Commission-designated Thrombectomy-Capable Stroke Center, Jupiter Medical Center stands at the forefront of stroke diagnosis and treatment, with a team specially trained to manage the most complex conditions. This prestigious certification, awarded in collaboration with the American Heart Association/American Stroke Association (AHA/ASA), recognizes hospitals that meet rigorous standards for performing endovascular thrombectomy and delivering comprehensive post-procedural care.

To earn this designation, programs must comply with ten evidence-based core measures developed under the guidance of the AHA/ASA, standards considered best practice in stroke care. Jupiter Medical Center is proud to be 100% compliant, ensuring the highest level of care for acute stroke emergencies. The Stroke Center is equipped with advanced imaging technology, specialized medical equipment, neurological intensive care units for critical cases, neurosurgical operating rooms, and step-down units. Its team includes physicians and specialists trained in vascular medicine, neurology, neurosurgery, and minimally invasive endovascular treatments.

JMC's leadership in stroke care has earned national recognition. In 2024, the American Heart Association awarded the center the Get With The Guidelines® - Stroke GOLD PLUS Honor Roll Elite Plus Award, representing the highest achievement in key quality measures. Additionally, U.S. News & World Report named Jupiter Medical Center a High Performing Hospital for Stroke for 2024-2025, the highest distinction in its Best Hospitals Procedures & Conditions ratings.

Combining speed, innovation, and expertise, Jupiter Medical Center delivers comprehensive stroke care and advanced neurological procedures. Its capabilities include thrombectomy-certified stroke treatment, Viz AI technology to expedite stroke care, neuro-endovascular surgery, a dedicated neurological critical care unit, advanced imaging such as 3T MRI, and innovative rehabilitation therapies-all designed to optimize outcomes and restore quality of life.

Women's and Children's Services

Jupiter Medical Center's Florence A. De George Children's & Women's Services delivers care for women and children in a setting designed for comfort, safety, and advanced medical excellence. The Florence A. De George Obstetrics Unit features spacious, private birthing suites, complemented by the Level II De George Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, which provides specialized care for babies as early as 30 weeks' gestation.

Pediatric services include the Mastroianni Family Pediatric Emergency Department, treating over 8,500 children annually. Consistently voted the best place to have a baby in Palm Beach County, Jupiter Medical Center's birthing center combines luxury and modern amenities with cutting-edge technology and expert care. In 2024, the center celebrated a record-breaking year, welcoming more than 2,500 newborns. The hospital is also proud to be National Safe Sleep Hospital Certified, underscoring its commitment to the highest standards of safety for infants and families.

The Margaret W. Niedland Breast Center

The Margaret W. Niedland Breast Center is preparing for a major expansion, with completion targeted for 2027. This project will significantly enhance imaging and diagnostic capabilities to meet growing patient demand. Plans include adding an additional MRI at Niedland to complement the two existing units at Jupiter Medical Center and the current unit at Niedland. A mobile MRI is scheduled for JMC in January as an interim solution. CT capacity will also increase with the addition of a second CT scanner at Niedland and shell space reserved for a third unit.

Ultrasound services will expand with the installation of a second general ultrasound and a fifth breast ultrasound room, with space for a sixth in the future. Mammography capabilities will grow from four rooms to six, ensuring faster access and improved patient convenience. Additional enhancements include an expanded outpatient laboratory and a larger registration area to streamline the patient experience.

The Community

Jupiter, Florida

Known for its stunning beaches, vibrant community, and rich history, Jupiter, Florida, is a coastal community located in Palm Beach County. A majority of the patients served by Jupiter Medical Center reside in northern Palm Beach County and southeast Martin County. Palm Beach County is the state's fourth-largest county with a population of 1.5 million. As of 2024, Palm Beach County is Florida's fifth-wealthiest county, with several key industries driving its growth, including healthcare, tourism, engineering, life sciences, and agriculture. Jupiter offers a high quality of life with excellent schools, healthcare facilities, and a variety of housing options. The town has a mix of residential areas, from waterfront properties to family-friendly neighborhoods. Jupiter is famous for its pristine beaches, such as Jupiter Beach and Carlin Park, and boasts several parks, including Dubois Park and Riverbend Park, which offer a variety of outdoor activities, including hiking, kayaking, and picnicking. The historic Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse, built in 1860, is a prominent landmark offering breathtaking views and an adjacent museum that provides insights into the region's history. The area is also home to a diverse array of wildlife, including sea turtles and manatees, with popular attractions such as the Loggerhead Marinelife Center dedicated to sea turtle conservation. Jupiter has a strong sense of community with numerous events and festivals throughout the year. Cultural hubs like the Maltz Jupiter Theatre offer a range of performances and shows. The town also features sidewalk dining, weekly events, live concerts at Abacoa Town Center and Harbourside Place, and Broadway shows at the Maltz Jupiter Theatre, providing ample entertainment options. Roger Dean Stadium, located in Jupiter, is the only stadium in the country to host four minor league teams (Jupiter Hammerheads, Palm Beach Cardinals, Gulf Coast Marlins, and Gulf Coast Cardinals) and two Major League teams (Miami Marlins and St. Louis Cardinals) annually for spring training.



West Palm Beach (Wall Street South)

Located about 20 miles south of Jupiter, West Palm Beach is a vibrant city generally known for its luxurious estates and iconic landmarks. However, in recent years, the business spotlight has shifted to West Palm Beach, where major Wall Street firms, such as Goldman Sachs, have set up offices. Real estate moguls Steve Ross and Ken Himmel are key players in West Palm's transformation, with multiple commercial and residential projects underway, including the development of a central retail area called The Square. Palm Beach County is experiencing significant growth, boasting a vibrant economy, an AAA bond rating from all major agencies, high per capita income levels, and an impressively low unemployment rate of 2.3%.

Surrounding Areas

The areas surrounding Jupiter also have much to offer. Just north of Jupiter, Tequesta is a charming village known for its quiet neighborhoods, parks, and the Loxahatchee River, making it an ideal destination for boating and fishing enthusiasts. Located to the south, Palm Beach Gardens is known for its upscale shopping, dining, and golf courses, with The Gardens Mall being a popular destination for shoppers. To the north, Hobe Sound is known for its natural beauty, including Jonathan Dickinson State Park, which offers hiking, camping, and wildlife viewing opportunities. South of Jupiter, Juno Beach is famous for its beautiful coastline and the Juno Beach Pier, a favorite spot for fishing and enjoying ocean views. Miami, located south of Jupiter, offers convenient access not only to a major business hub with a rapidly expanding tech and startup ecosystem, but also to a vibrant cultural center known for its global culinary scene and thriving arts districts. Orlando, an internationally renowned destination for families and home to world-famous theme parks, is located northwest of Jupiter.
